sightseeing, recreational activities, cultural events and outings you don't have to take



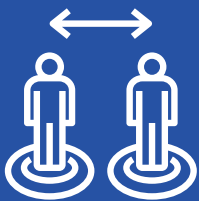
## LIMIT HOUSEHOLD GATHERINGS

your hands often

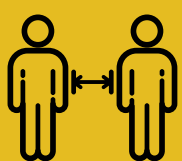
For Upper Campus Families: 5 Day Quarantine for those who do not travel or host out of state. Distance learning for all Upper Campus students from February 22 to 26.

For Upper Campus Families: February Baseline COVID-19 Testing will take place on February 22. A negative result is required before students may return to in-person learning on March 1.

For Lower Campus Families: students who do not travel/host out of state may return on February 22.

For All Families: Any family who travels by air/car out of state, or hosts the same, will be required to quarantine for 14 days and engage in distance learning from the day they returned or guests have departed.

For example, if travel or hosting is completed on February 21, students will be able to attend in-person on March 8.
